Whereas, since 1975, students with disabilities have been educated in Levy County Public School System with the passing of P.L. 94-142 by Congress.

Whereas, School Board of Levy County has over 700 teachers, administrators, Para educators, contracted staff, and support staff committed to providing quality educational services to students with disabilities.

Whereas, Exceptional Student Education offers students with disabilities experiences and opportunities that will enable individuals to obtain postsecondary education, enter the workforce and contribute to their communities.

Whereas, School Board of Levy County has approximately 950 students identified with special needs who receive a quality education in the Least Restrictive Environment.



Therefore, be it resolved, that the School Board of Levy County does hereby proclaim the first two weeks of October as:


Disability History and Awareness Weeks
